They will obtain a signed permission form from instructor for lessons on Secondary instrument/voice, Piano class and Alexander Technique (optional).

TUESDAY, JUNE 25

8:30 AM - 4:00 PM	Register and pay for Optional Secondary lessons, Piano class, Alexander Technique, Guitar Lessons in Camp Office. You may have already pre-registered and paid, but for Secondary Lessons and Guitar Lessons, a signed form by the instructor is required for final registration. We accept Cash, Check, Visa & MasterCard (credit/debit). Parents can call on this day with credit card information to 828-262-4091. Forms are also available online under "Handbook & Forms."
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PARENTS/GUARDIANS: We strongly recommend that your child register as early in the day as possible. - Bring your instrument! If renting an instrument, e-mail the camp office to [confirm](mailto:confirm@campoffice.com) reservation.
- Instrumentalists: don't forget your folding music stand!
- Percussionists: don't forget your sticks! Pianist and Voice: bring music you are studying.
- For your audition placement, bring your music if requested. See Ensemble Audition form in this packet for more information.
- Review "What to Bring list" & Camper Handbook on what bed linens size you will need and other items to bring. Bring an umbrella, as you will be walking about campus.
- Look at concert schedule and plan your outfits accordingly. Refer to Camper Handbook for proper dress attire.
